MATH & SENSORIAL

"L" & "#6" WEEK-Our number of the week in Spanish is seis and our color is orange-naranja in Spanish. Some choice works included: counting ladybugs & a ladybug picnic, number recognition work, lacing numbers and a leaf matching. In sensorial we did the color links with the pattern cards. We practiced writing our 6's.

"F" & "#7" WEEK-Our number in Spanish is siete and our color pink, rosado in Spanish. We reviewed the shape oval, practiced writing 7's. In addition to our regular choice-works, we went fishing for a number and matched it to the air bubble related to that number. We also matched different fabric textures, played frog on a log and the pink cubes-grading from largest to smallest.

"C" & "#8" WEEK-We learned 8 is ocho in Spanish and our color of the week was brown, bazo in Spanish and our shape was an ellipse. Some choice works: a cake and candle number recognition game and a carrot counting game.



SCIENCE & GEOGRAPHY

"L" WEEK-We studied leaves and their many shapes, sizes and colors. They change looks for each season. In the Fall they change color and begin to fall from the trees. We read "Fall Leaves Fall" by Zoe Hall. We explored with light and created shadows. We studied lizards and learned they are a part of the reptile family. We learned about lions. We studied ladybugs and learned they are insects. They go through metamorphosis, the way butterflies do.

"F" WEEK-We learned about different kinds of farms and learned what kind of animals are found on the farm. We learned what food and other things come from a farm. What is a fish and where do they live? We learned about the lifecycle of a frog and that a baby frog is called a tadpole. Exploring with Floam!

"C" WEEK-The land on our Earth is divided into 7 parts called continents. We enjoyed learning our continent song. We live on the continent North America. We studied clouds and the different shapes they make & the names given to those shapes. We learned that animals camouflage themselves by blending into the environment around them.

MONTESSORI CORNER (Areas of the Montessori classroom)



Math & Sensorial-Through exploration using all 5 senses, the children learn sequencing, quantity of numbers & concepts of operation (addition & subtraction). Lessons introduce skills such as sequencing, number recognition through 100, fractions, counting with objects and recognizing our colors & numbers in Spanish.
